## SOP: Room D-Equipment Disinfection



To prevent the possible spread of disease in this room disinfecting equipment is essential.

## **Equipment needed:**

- 1. x1 unused cleaning cloths for biofilm cleaning
- 2. x1 unused cleaning cloth for disinfectant rinsing
- 3. Hydrogen peroxide
- 4. Ethanol
- 5. Paper towel

## Cleaning equipment:

- Used equipment can only be placed on the Dirty side of the sinks
- Using tap water and a new cleaning cloth, thoroughly clean 1 unit of equipment. Note:
  1 unit = all integral pieces for a single housing tank or box. Breeding boxes are inclusive of lids, inserts, and dividers; tanks are inclusive of lids, baffles, and siphons.
  - This step removes the biofilm from the equipment
- · Place cleaned items into Clean sink
  - Multiple cleaned pieces of equipment can be placed here
- Discard used cloth into dirty cloth bucket.
  - NEVER REUSE A CLEANING CLOTH FOR BIOFILM REMOVAL
- Once all pieces of equipment are clean, disinfect by spraying hydrogen peroxide on all surfaces of the equipment
  - Required contact time is 10 mins
  - Use timer on shelves for timing
- Disinfect Dirty side of sinks using surface disinfecting protocol (Ethanol)
- At the end of 10 minutes, using 1 cleaning cloth for all pieces of equipment and tap water, clean off the disinfectant from the equipment
- · Place disinfected equipment on Clean side of sinks
- Once all pieces are washed, move to Drying Rack
- Stack equipment in a manner that allows maximum air flow to optimise drying time
  - Do not stack equipment. Breeding boxes and inserts should be arranged in a pyramid shape
